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Stage Makeup

1. Eye Shadow: Apply appropriate color from middle of eyelid all the way up to the eyebrow. Blondes should use medium gray. Dark blondes, red heads, brown and black should use medium brown. No silvers, golds or sparkly colors.
2. Eye Liner: Use appropriate color – draw a **thin, straight** line on top and along the lash roots from the middle of the eyelid to underneath the outside end of the eyebrow. Draw a **straight parallel bottom line** from the middle of the eye extending out and ending under the top line just described. Blondes and red heads should use a medium brown. All others should use a dark brown.
3. Eyebrows: Draw a line through the center of the entire eyebrow using the eyeliner pencil. Gently blend in the line using your fingertip. Also medium brown and dark brown. Black only for really dark eyebrows.
4. Blush: Beginning under the center of the eye and following the cheekbone line, brush diagonally up and out. Do not apply blush into the hairline. Use a rose pink – none with orange or purple tints.
5. Apply lipstick. (NOTE: Please send lipstick with child so it can be reapplied just before performance.) Young children wear a dark pink. Older – a rose/cranberry. Red only when teacher requests.
6. **BOYS** – Follow instruction #2

Do not use make-up that is tinted purple, orange or brown as it looks unnatural on stage.

Hair

High lighted or blonde dyed hair may pick up stage lighting colors and can appear orange or green.

1. Begin by wetting the hair.
2. You can use a little mousse or gel and then comb through the hair, smoothing it out and pulling it tightly into a ponytail. The position of the ponytail should be diagonally back and up from the ears, on the flat spot of the head. Bun should be as flat as possible, not the shape of a door knob. No bangs on the forehead. Everything must be pulled straight back, no parts.
3. Wrap/twist the ponytail into a bun, **pinning as you go**. Take a hair net the same color as the hair and wrap over the finished bun. Use at least ten (10) bobby pins – thin hairpins *don't* hold securely.
4. Finish with **lots** of hairspray. There should be no wisps or loose hairs. Nothing should move when shaking the head.

Hair Supplies: Comb/brush, bobby pins or large/thick hair pins, hair elastic as close to the color of the hair, hair net, gel or mousse and hair spray.
